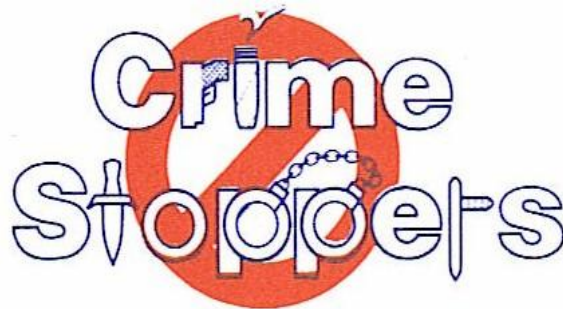

* On July 9, 2010, at approximately 5:30 p.m., the Macoupin County Sheriff's Department received a call from a subject stating that last night (7/8) her vehicle had a flat tire while she was traveling on Asbury Road approximately 150 yards west of Hettick/Scottville Road. Upon changing the tire it was discovered that the spare was also flat. Around 8:00 pm, the victim decided to leave the vehicle jacked up and return the next day after work to change the tire. The vehicle was checked by the victim at approximately 7:00 am on July 9th and everything was secure. At approximately 5:30 pm, the victim returned to change the tire and found that the vehicle had been completely burned to the ground. The damaged vehicle is described as a 1988 Oldsmobile Cutless Sierra.

* On July 11, 2010, at approximately 1:30 p.m., the Macoupin County Sheriff's Department was dispatched to the corner of Colbrook Road and Birdfarm Road. Upon arrival the victim advised that he had moved his 1985 trailer to this location about a year ago to fix it up so he could move into the trailer. The victim stated upon arriving to the trailer today, he discovered that the trailer had been set on fire which resulted in a total loss. It is believed that this arson happened during the early morning hours on July 11, 2010.
